Diploma Programme (DP). All students in grades 7<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> are a part of MYP which is in the final stages of authorization. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students can choose one or all of the rigorous DP courses offered.

### **What is the IB program?**

The International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP) is designed for middle and early high school students in preparation for the Diploma Programme (IB DP). In addition, the MYP at Eastern continues with the Chinese Immersion language program from our elementary school, Post Oak Elementary (PYP). The focus of international-mindedness encourages personal growth with a balanced approach to academics, community involvement and extra-curricular activities. The same IB concepts are used at schools in 130 countries and challenge students to think globally and ponder how they and others interact with and affect the world around them.
